RULES AND PROCEDURES

- Current UNSW postgraduate coursework Law students can use this form to apply to articulate from:
 - Graduate Diploma in Law (5740) to Master of Law (9200)
 - Master of Law (9200) to Graduate Diploma in Law (5740)
 - Graduate Diploma in International Law and International Relations (5760) to Master of International Law and International Relations (9240)
 - Master of International Law and International Relations (9240) to Graduate Diploma in International Law and International Relations (5760)
 - Graduate Diploma in Legal Studies (5750) to Master of Legal Studies (9220)
 - Master of Legal Studies (9220) to Graduate Diploma in Legal Studies (5750)
 - Graduate Diploma in Human Rights Law and Policy (5211) to Master of Human Rights Law and Policy (9211)
 - Master of Human Rights Law and Policy (9211) to Graduate Diploma in Human Rights Law and Policy (5211)
- Articulation is subject to the approval of the Coordinator Postgraduate Education and achievement of satisfactory progress in the current degree program.
- Graduate Diploma students are expected to have satisfactorily completed at least 16 UOC in approved courses, to be eligible to apply to articulate to the appropriate Masters program.
- ***Graduate Diploma Students can apply to articulate to the appropriate Masters program ONLY if their Graduate Diploma program has not been completed.*** Students who have completed and been awarded their Graduate Diploma cannot articulate but may apply for Admission to the appropriate Masters program. If your application to the Masters program is successful, you will then be governed by the advanced standing rules applicable for the appropriate Masters program.
- ***Masters Program Students can apply to articulate to the appropriate Graduate Diploma program ONLY if their Masters program has not been completed.*** Students who have completed and been awarded their Masters cannot articulate but may apply for Admission to the appropriate Graduate Diploma program. If your application to the Graduate Diploma program is successful, you will then be governed by the advanced standing rules applicable for the appropriate Graduate Diploma program.
- Your application for articulation of studies MUST be received at least one month prior to the start of the semester in which you want the articulation to be effective. E.g. If you are enrolled in the Graduate Diploma in Law in S2 2007 and wish to articulate to the Master of Law in S1 2008, your application for articulation of studies must be submitted at least one month prior to the start of S1 2008.
