International Exchange Students From Other Law Schools

Core Courses

Enrolment in the compulsory core courses is generally restricted to UNSW LLB students.

In special circumstances exchange students may be permitted to enrol in the core courses providing

all prerequisites have been met and there are spaces available.

Elective Courses

Enrolment in the Kingsford Legal Centre courses (Clinical Legal Experience) is restricted to UNSW students

only as places are limited.

Enrolment in other electives is possible providing all prerequisites have been met and there are spaces available.

Due to limited places available in each elective, exchange students should lodge their application for admissions as early as possible (see below).

Deadline for Lodging Applications

The Law School teaches in small classes and is only able to reserve a small number of places in each class. For this reason, exchange students are strongly advised to confirm their preferred electives by the first week of December if possible.
