

History and Theory of International Law (LAWS4084)

Examine some of the fundamental issues underlying international law against the background of its historical and ongoing development in this postgraduate course taught by Visiting Lecturer, Dr Ulf Linderfalk, Associate Professor in International Law at Lund University, Sweden.

Course focus:

This course will focus on the Fragmentation of International Law and examine 2 key questions:

- If we wish to prevent tendencies towards disintegration of the international legal system, what legal means and methods are we able to use?
- To what extent are the means and methods offered by international law sufficient, and to what extent do new strands of development in international relations and law-making call for a legal revision?

Lecturer:

Dr Ulf Linderfalk is an Associate Professor in International Law at Lund University in Sweden. His research focuses on issues concerning the underlying structure of the international legal system, in particular, the problem of fragmentation, which forms the central thesis of this course.

Dr Linderfalk's publications include, *'On the Interpretation of Treaties'* (Springer Verlag, 2007) which analyses the rules relating to the interpretation of international written agreements.
