Law

In 2011, [UNSW Law](#) and the [University of Lausanne](#) signed a unique exchange agreement which allows Master of Laws (LLM) students at UNSW to complete a semester of study in an unrivalled international setting with one of Europe's most prestigious universities. The University of Lausanne is situated a short distance from Geneva and its international organisations and visits to these organisations will form an important part of the exchange experience.



LLM program at the University of Lausanne

The LLM at the University of Lausanne offers two specialisations in **International and European Economic Law** and **International and European Commercial Law**. A number of courses are available under each of these specialisations.

UNSW students are required to complete 26 ECTS (equals 24 units of credit at UNSW) including the following compulsory courses (12 ECTS):

- **International Economic Law** (with excursion to Bern and Zurich) 4 ECTS
- **International Business Transactions** 4 ECTS
- **European Internal Market Law** 4 ECTS

The remaining 14 ECTS in courses can be completed from the list of electives which can be viewed on the [University of Lausanne website](#).

Excursions to International Organisations

There are a number of excursions included to International Organisations based in Geneva and Brussels. The LLM at the University of Lausanne aims at preparing lawyers from around the world for high-level challenges in a globalised economy with a special focus on the role of the European Union and its legal order. The programme combines theory and practice in a number of core legal fields relevant for the world economy.

University of Lausanne

The University of Lausanne is situated a short distance from Geneva and its international organisations. Courses are taught in English by distinguished academics as well as practitioners working in government, in international law firms, in legal departments of major corporations and in international organisations in Geneva as well as in the EU institutions in Brussels and Strasbourg. The University of Lausanne has been engaged in teaching law since 1537 when the Academy of Lausanne was founded. Students will also have the opportunity to learn or improve their French language skills with the university offering a broad range of classes

Eligibility and Applications

UNSW Master of Laws (9200) students who have completed 24uoc and whose academic standing is GOOD are eligible to apply.
